Glory be- A Christian Prayer praising the Holy Trinity

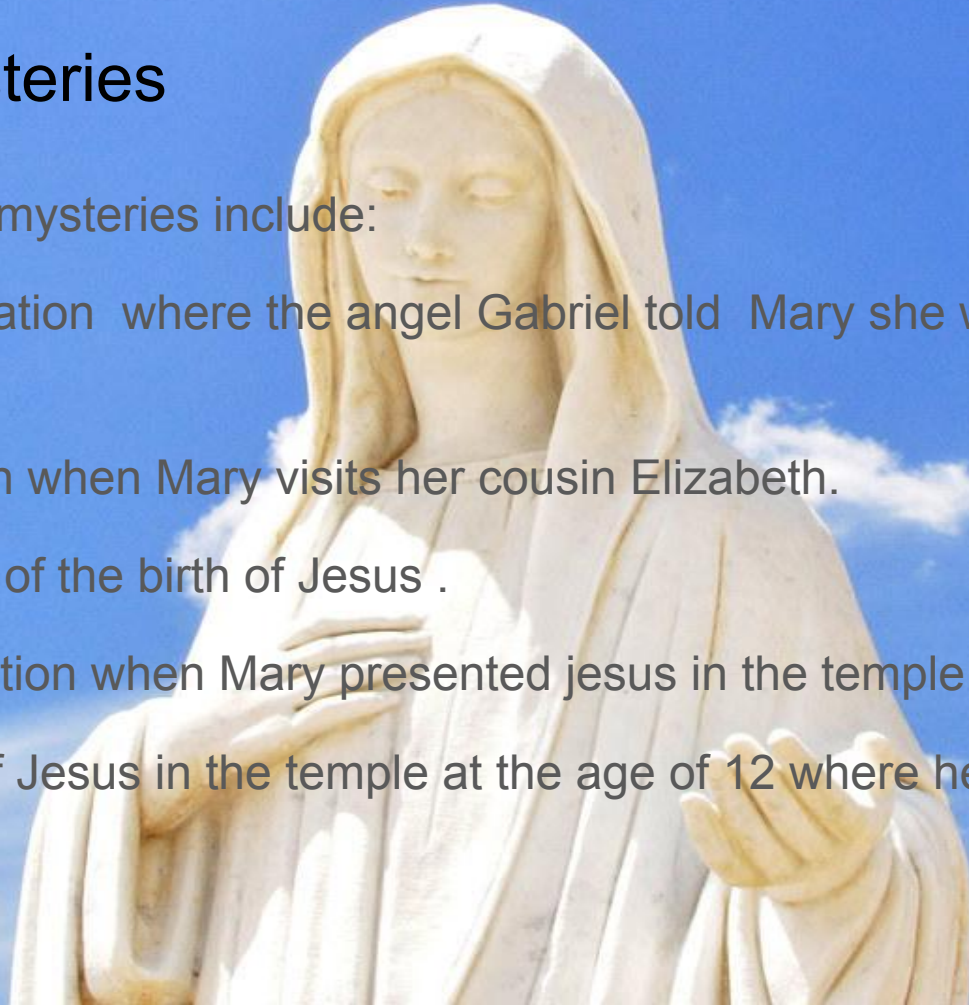
APOSTLES CREED-Tells us about what Catholics believe in.

- 4The Presentation when Mary presented Jesus in the temple.
- 5The finding of Jesus in the temple at the age of 12 where he found teaching

2 The wedding at Cana

3 The proclamation of the kingdom.

4 The transfiguration

5 The institution of the Eucharist.



# Sorrowful Mysteries



The **Sorrowful Mysteries** of the Rosary focus on the sad and painful times in Jesus' life, especially around His death.

For example, the carrying of the cross.

# Glorious Mysteries

The Glorious Mysteries are about the five key events that occurred after Jesus Resurrection.

For example:

- The ascension of Jesus into heaven
- The resurrection of Jesus when he appeared to his disciples
